The NeuroModulation Technique Research Institute is currently recruiting children ages 5 - 10 with a diagnosis of Autism at 22 research sites across the United States to participate in a study to determine if NeuroModulation Technique (NMT) is effective in reducing maladaptive behaviors and increasing adaptive behaviors in children diagnosed with autism.

Participants must have had a formal diagnosis of Autism for at least one year and meet other eligibility criteria.

Children accepted into the study will receive 12 sessions of NeuroModulation Technique twice a week for 6 weeks. All assessments and treatments will be provided at no cost to participants.

NeuroModulation Technique is a safe, gentle and non-invasive therapy that has been used to improve functioning in a variety of areas.
